- ii. Guarantee that they will supply spare parts, if and when required on agreed basis for an agreed price. The agreed basis could be and including but with any limitation an agreed discount on the published catalogue or an agreed percentage of profit on the landed cost.
- iii. Warranty to the effect that before going out of production for the spare parts they will give adequate advance notice to the Buyer (farmer) of the equipment so that the latter may undertake the balance of the lifetime requirements. The rates quoted shall include loading and unloading during the contract period.
13. Shall not levy higher rates than the accepted rates in the RfP.
14. If at any time, during the said period the Bidder reduces the sale price, sells or offer to sell such _____ (____ - Schedule) to any person/organization including the Buyer (farmer) or any Dept, of central Govt., or any Department of the State Government or any Statutory undertaking of the Central or state Government as the case may be at a price lower than the price chargeable under the contract shall forthwith notify such reduction or sale or offer of sale wishes not later than 30 days from the date of such sale to the Director Department of Agriculture, Government of Karnataka and the price payable under the contract for the _____ (____ - Schedule) of such reduction of sale or offer of the sale shall stand correspondingly reduced.
15. The above stipulation will, however, not apply to:-
- Exports by the Bidder.
 - Sale of goods as original equipment at price lower than the prices charged for normal replacement.
 - Sale of goods at lower price on or after the date of completion of sale/placement of the order of goods by the authority concerned under the existing or previous Rate Contracts as also under any previous contracts entered into with the Central or State Govt. Depts., including their undertakings excluding joint sector companies and/or private parties and bodies.
 - The Bidder shall furnish the following certificate to the Paying Authority along with each bill for payment for supplies made against the Rate contract – “We certify that there has been no reduction in sale price of the _____ (____ - Schedule) of _____ description identical to the _____ (____ - Schedule) supplied to the Government under the contract herein and such _____ (____ - Schedule) have not been offered/sold by me/us to any person/ organization including the purchaser or any department of Central Government or any Department of a state Government or any Statutory Undertaking of the Central or state Government as the case may be up to the date of bill/the date of completion of supplies against all supply orders placed during the currency of the Rate Contract at price lower than the price charged to the government under the contract except for quantity of _____ (____ - Schedule) categories under sub-clauses (a),(b) and (c) above.
16. **Franking Clause:** The following Franking Clause will form part of the contract placed on successful bidder:-
- Franking Clause in the case of Acceptance of Goods** - The fact that the goods have been inspected after the delivery period and passed by the inspecting Officer will not have the effect of keeping the contract alive. The

goods are being passed without prejudice to the rights of the Buyer (farmer) under the terms and conditions of the contract.

- ii. **Franking Clause in the case of Rejection of Goods** -The fact that the goods have been inspected after the delivery period and rejected by the Inspecting Officer will not bind the Buyer (farmer) in any manner. The goods are being rejected without prejudice to the rights of the Buyer (farmer) under the terms and conditions of the contract.

17. In the event of the Bidder's failure to submit the Bonds, Guarantees and Documents, deliver _____ (____ - Schedule) as per this RFP within the contracted delivery period, etc., as specified in this contract, the Department may, at his discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The Department may also deduct from the BIDDER as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the delayed/undelivered _____ (____ - Schedule) mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed _____ (____ - Schedule) /services.
18. The suppliers receiving the DD towards the farmers share/ Govt. subsidy the supplier shall bear the DD commission charges. The fee for transferring the farmers share shall be borne by the supplier.
19. Any change in any duty/tax upward/downward as a result of any statutory variation in excise taking place within contract terms shall be allowed to the extent of actual quantum of such duty/tax paid by the OEM/ Manufacturer/ Importer /MoU holder. Similarly, in case of downward revision in any duty/tax, the actual quantum of reduction of such duty/tax shall be reimbursed to the Buyer(farmer) by the Empanelled firm. All such adjustments shall include all reliefs, exemptions, rebates, concession etc. if any obtained by the Empanelled firm.
20. The Department has the right to reject delayed supplies.
21. If any information provided by the RC Holder is found to be factually false or misleading such empanelled firms will summarily be removed from the Empanelled list (RC), any time during the validity period of the RfP and liable for penalties as applicable.
22. Shall ensure supply of materials as per the bill, duly in conformity with the Rate Contract and Contract validity orders.
23. The indented materials shall be supplied at the sites specified by the indenting officer.
24. The Department Authorities will visit/inspect the Manufacturing Unit/Premises of the approved firms.
25. The Manufacturer/ OEM/ Importer/ MoU holder/ AE within the delivery period should deliver the _____ (____ - Schedule) to the farmer.
26. If the OEM/ Manufacturer/ Importer has been empanelled in the RFP then he has to submit the district wise, Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the Equipments supplied along with e-Way bills on the 10th day of every month to the Director of Agriculture during the agreement period.
27. If the OEM/ Manufacturer/ Importer has been empanelled in the RFP, who is unable to give the bill and has appointed AE for supply of material and Bills, then OEM/ Manufacturer/ Importer has to submit Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the Equipments supplied to the Appointed Entity along with e-Way bills and the AE has to submit district wise, Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the Equipments supplied along with e-Way bills on the 10th day of every month.

28. If MOU holder has been empanelled in the RFP, then the concerned OEM/ Manufacturer/ Importer of the MOU holder has to submit the Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the equipment's supplied to the MOU holder and empanelled MOU holder has to submit the district-wise, Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the Equipments supplied along with e-Way bills on the 10th day of every month to the Director of Agriculture during the agreement period.

29. **Risk & Expense clause.**

i. In case, the Manufacturer/ OEM/ Importer/ MoU holder/ AE as the case maybe does not submit district wise, Item wise, Model wise details of the quantity of the Equipments supplied along with e-Way bills on the 10th day of every month, the Department without prejudice shall have the right to declare the contract as cancelled either wholly or to the extent of such default and forfeit the PBGs of such bidders.

ii. Should the _____
(____ - Schedule) or any installment thereof not be delivered within the time or times specified in the contract documents, or if defective delivery is made in respect of the _____
(____ - Schedule) or any installment thereof, the Buyer (farmer) shall after granting the Bidder 45 days to cure the breach, be at liberty, without prejudice to the right to recover liquidated damages as a remedy for breach of contract, to declare the contract as cancelled either wholly or to the extent of such default.

iii. Should the _____
(____ - Schedule) or any installment thereof not perform in accordance with the specifications /parameters provided by the BIDDER during the check proof tests to be done in the BUYER (FARMER)'s country, the BUYER (FARMER) shall be at liberty, without prejudice to any other remedies for breach of contract, to cancel the contract wholly or to the extent of such default.

iv. In case of a material breach that was not remedied within 45 days, the BUYER (FARMER) shall, having given the right of first refusal to the BIDDER be at liberty to purchase, manufacture, or procure from any other source as he thinks fit, other _____ (____ - Schedule) of the same or similar description to make good:-

a Such default.

b In the event of the contract being wholly determined the balance of the _____ (____ -

Schedule) remaining to be delivered there under.

v. Any excess of the purchase price, cost of manufacturer, or value of any _____ (____ - Schedule) procured from any other Manufacturer as the case may be, over the contract price appropriate to such default or balance shall be recoverable from the BIDDER.

30. **Force Majeure Clause.**

i. Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non-performance of any of its obligations (except for failure to pay any sum which has become due on account of receipt of goods under the provisions of the present contract), if the non-performance results from such Force Majeure circumstances as flood, Fire, Earth Quake and other acts of God as well as

War, Military operation, blockade, Acts or Actions of State Authorities or any other circumstances beyond the parties control that have arisen after the conclusion of the present contract.

- ii. In such circumstances the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the present contract is extended correspondingly for the period of time of action of these circumstances and their consequences.
- iii. The party for which it becomes impossible to meet obligations under this contract due to Force Majeure conditions, is to notify in written form the other party of the beginning and cessation of the above circumstances immediately, but in any case not later than 10 (Ten) days from the moment of their beginning.
- iv. Certificate of a Chamber of Commerce (Commerce and Industry) or other competent authority or organization of the respective country shall be sufficient proof of commencement and cessation of the above circumstances.
- v. If the impossibility of complete or partial performance of an obligation lasts for than 6 (six) months, either party hereto reserves the right to terminate the contract totally or partially upon giving prior written notice of 30 (Thirty) days to the other party of the intention to terminate without any liability other than reimbursement on the terms provided in the agreement for the goods received.

31. **Transportation:** The following Transportation clause will form part of the contract placed on successful Bidder:-

- (a) The _____ (____ - Schedule) shall be delivered to the Buyer (farmer) of the State of Karnataka.
- (b) The date of issue of receipt by the Buyer (farmer) shall be considered as the date of delivery.
- (c) The Prices empanelled by the Department of Agriculture, GoK is inclusive of all applicable taxes and transportation cost.

32. **Quality:** The _____ quality of _____ the _____ (____ - Schedule) delivered accordingly to the present contract shall correspond to the technical conditions and standards / specifications enumerated as per RFP and shall also include therein modifications to the machines and equipment suggested by the Department. Such modifications will be mutually agreed to. The bidder confirms that the _____ (____ - Schedule) to be supplied under this contract shall be new i.e. not manufactured before (year of contract), and shall incorporate all the latest improvements and modifications thereto and spares of improved and modified equipment are backward integrated and interchangeable with some equipment supplied by the bidder in the past if any. The bidder shall supply a performance guarantee certificate and literature on dismantling and assembly procedure. The bidder should submit valid test report for the _____ (____ - Schedule) of FMTTIs or designated testing centers of DAC&FW.

33. **Quality Assurance:** The item should be of the latest manufacture, conforming to the current production standard and having 100% defined life at the time of delivery.

34. **Claims:** The following Claims clause will form part of the contract placed on Successful Bidder:-

- i. The claims may be presented either: (i) on quantity of the _____ (____ - Schedule), where the quantity does not correspond to the quantity shown or

- (ii) on quality of the machines and equipment, where quality does not correspond to the quality mentioned in the contract.
- ii. The quantity claims for deficiency of quantity shall be presented within 45 days of completion of inspection and acceptance of goods. The quantity claim shall be submitted to the successful bidder.
- iii. The quality claim for defects or deficiencies in quality noticed during the inspection shall be presented within 10 days of completion of inspection and acceptance of machinery and equipment. Quality claims shall be presented for defects or deficiencies in quality noticed during warranty period earliest but not later than 10 days after expiry of the guarantee period.
- iv. The Manufacturer/OEM/ Importer/ MOU holder/ AE shall collect the defective or rejected goods from the location nominated by the Buyer (farmer) and deliver the repaired or replaced goods at the same location under Bidder's arrangement.
35. In respect of any dispute arising out of implementation of this RfP, the decision of the Tender Accepting Authority (Commissioner for Agriculture) shall be final.
36. **Arbitration.**- Any dispute or difference or claim arising out of, or in connection with, or relating to the present contract or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be referred and settled under Arbitration Center, Karnataka (Domestic and International) Rules 2012. Arbitrator in this case will be the Additional Chief Secretary cum Development Commissioner. Arbitration proceedings shall be held in Bangalore. The language of the arbitration proceedings and that of all documents and communications between the parties shall be **English**.
37. Any disputes or discrepancies in the supply of the tendered machinery by the RC Holder or its authorized MoU holder or Authorized Entity of the concerned Manufacturer or OEM or Importer or MoU holder will be held responsible.
38. **Termination of Contract.** The Department shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full by serving of notice of 30days to the Manufacturer/ OEM/ Importer/ MoU holder in any of the following cases:-
- The delivery of the material is delayed for causes not attributable to Force Majeure for more than 01 (one) month after the scheduled date of delivery.
 - The Bidder is declared bankrupt or becomes insolvent.
 - The delivery of material is delayed due to causes of force Majeure by more than 01 (one) month provided force Majeure clause is included in contract.
 - The Department has noticed that the Bidder has utilized the services of any Indian/Foreign agent in getting this contract and paid any commission to such individual/company etc.,
 - As per decision of the Arbitration Tribunal.
 - When the OEM/ Manufacturer/Importer/ MOU holder fails to honor any part of the contract including failure to deliver the contracted _____ (____ - Schedule) /render service in time.
 - Any special circumstances, which must be recorded to justify the cancellation or termination of a contract
39. This approval of Rate Contract holder is being issued with no financial commitment and the Department of Agriculture, Government of Karnataka reserves the right to change or vary any part thereof at any stage. The Department also reserves the right to withdraw the empanelled firm, should it become necessary at any stage.
40. Payment Terms: No advance payment shall be made. The payments could be made through ECS/NEFT/Cheque mechanism, wherever feasible. The supply bill/invoice should be in the name of empanelled firms only.

41. The empanelled firms who do not supply the machinery as per the indent placed from the Taluka ADA office or concerned department officers during the Agreement period of the current RfP will be blacklisted for subsequent 03 years.
42. Shall agree and abide to all the terms and conditions given in the RfP.
43. Any deviations in the above and the RfP (Request for Proposal) (including all the addendums and corrigendum's issued in e-Procurement platform) terms & conditions vide notification no RfP Notification No. **DDA(FM&MI)/ FM RFP/ A3 onwards/ 2019-20, Dt.16-08-2019** and will be treated as violation. If any empanelled firm is found in such situation/s, such empanelled firm shall be blacklisted and shall be disqualified to participate in any tender for the next three years and also shall make good the loss to the beneficiary. Further the BG (Bank Guarantee) shall be forfeited for any violation of RfP conditions.

Whereas, the second party is at full liberty to forfeit the Bank Guarantee apart from withholding the balance subsidy amount, cancelling the Rate Contract and Contract validity and blacklist the first party in case of breach of any of the terms and conditions agreed above.
